



BATHURST URBAN WATERWAYS MANAGEMENT PLAN PUBLIC FORUM MEETING

Cenwest Environmental Services, a locally-based consultancy, has been commissioned by Bathurst Regional Council (BRC) to undertake the preparation of the Bathurst Urban Waterways Management Plan (BUWMP). BRC in conjunction with the Central West Catchment Management Authority has identified the need to develop a Plan to provide a record of the present condition of Bathurst urban waterways and provide long-term strategies for their management and restoration.

The Plan targets the six main creeks and their tributaries contained within the former Bathurst City local government area, including Queen Charlotte Vale, Hawthornden, Jordan, Sawpit, Raglan and Saltram Creeks.
